Please find an original and five (5) copies of XO Communications Services, LLC's West Virginia Tariff No. 2 filing. This revision modifies Rules and Regulations language related to dedicated long distance. Customers are being advised of this increase via the bill message below:

Notice for Dedicated Long Distance Service Customers

Dedicated Long Distance service should only be utilized by the end-user for their long distance traffic. Effective January 1, 2014, customers of Dedicated Long Distance service who elect to place local calls across such service (intentionally or unintentionally) will be billed at the applicable Dedicated Long Distance Intrastate Rate Per Minute and the associated charges will not be included toward any Customer long distance commitment level.

3.4 Use of Service

3.4.1 Service furnished by the Company may be used for one or more of the following:

- (a) for the transmission of communications by the Customer;
- (b) for the transmission of communications to or from an authorized user or joint user;
- (c) for the transmission of communications to or from a Customer of another common carrier, which has subscribed to the Company's communications service for purposes of resale.

3.4.2 Service furnished by the Company may be arranged for joint use or authorized use. The joint user or authorized user shall be permitted to use such service in the same manner as the Customer, but subject to the following:

- (a) One joint user or authorized user must be designated as the Customer. The designated Customer does not necessarily have to have communications requirements of its own. The Customer must specifically name all joint users or authorized users in the application for service. Orders that involve the start, rearrangement, or discontinuance of joint use or authorized use service will be accepted by the Company only from that Customer and will be subject to all provisions of this tariff.
- (b) All charges for the service will be computed as if the service were to be billed to one Customer. The joint user or authorized user that has been designated as the Customer will be billed for all components of the service and will be responsible for all payments to the Company. In the event that the designated Customer fails to pay the Company each joint user or authorized user shall be liable to the Company for all charges incurred as a result of its use of the Company's service.

Each joint or authorized user must submit to the designated Customer a letter accepting contingent liability for its portion of all charges billed by the Company to the designated Customer. This letter must specify that the joint or authorized user understands that the Company will receive a copy of the guaranty from the designated Customer. Unless supportive services are provided, the Customer shall be responsible for allocating charges to each joint user or authorized user.

3.4.3 Dedicated long distance is to be used for long distance service only. Customers of dedicated long distance service, who elect to place local calls across such service, either intentionally or unintentionally, will be billed at the applicable dedicated long distance intrastate rate per minute and the associated charges will not be included toward any Customer long distance commitment level.
