RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable where service is available.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial water service.

RATES (customers with metered rates)

\$12.72 per 1,000 gallons of water usage.

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts, according to the size of meter installed:

5/8	- inch meter	\$ 34.50 per month
3/4	- inch meter	\$ 51.75 per month
1	- inch meter	\$ 86.25 per month
1-1/4	- inch meter	\$ 120.75 per month
1-1/2	- inch meter	\$ 172.50 per month
2	- inch meter	\$ 276.00 per month
3	- inch meter	\$ 517.50 per month
4	- inch meter	\$ 862.50 per month
6	- inch meter	\$1,725.00 per month
8	- inch meter	\$2,760.00 per month
10	- inch meter	\$4,416.00 per month

The above minimum charges are subject to an additional \$1.22 per 1,000 gallons usage

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is only to be collected once for each bill where it is appropriate.

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RECONNECTION CHARGE \$25.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water.

ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

In the event the District collects payment in full of a delinquent water bill at the customer's premises in lieu of a discontinuance of service for nonpayment, an administrative fee of \$25.00 shall also be collected in addition to the delinquent water bill.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$5.23 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such unusual consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District or a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be change by the applicable statutory provisions.
