RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable in entire territory served

(C) AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial service and retail water service.

(I) MINIMUM CHARGE

No minimum bill will be rendered for less than the following amounts, according to the size of the meter installed:

(N) LATEST PAY DATEThe last date, which shall be no sooner than the 20th day following the date the utility mails the bill that the bill may be paid without incurring a late payment penalty. Such date must be stated on the face of the bill.(N) DELINQUENT BILL

Any bill by the city that is not paid within thirty (30) days of the bill due date shall be considered a delinquent bill. Said date must be stated on the face of the bill.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

(N) DEPOSIT FOR WATER UTILITY SERVICE

A deposit of \$50 will be required for new water utility service and a \$50 deposit will be required for new sewage utility service prior to these utilities service being connected.

(C,I) RECONNECTION CHARGE

Whenever water service has been disconnected for any reason, a disconnection fee of \$50 shall be charged. Whenever water service which has been previously disconnected for any reason is reconnected, a reconnection fee of \$50 shall be charged.

TAP FEE

The charge for making each service connection shall be \$250.00 to make an ordinary connection to the water system. Project service connections shall be charged \$100.00 if paid prior to bidding of the project, \$250.00 if paid after the project has been bid.

(C) RETURNED CHECK FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the City of Cameron up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.

(I) INCREMENTAL LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$1.43 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.

(N) LEAKS ON THE CUSTOMER'S SIDE OF THE METER

The city shall develop and implement a written policy concerning the adjustment of customer bills where the bill reflects unusual usage which can be attributed to leakage on the customer's side of the meter. Leaking commodes, dripping facets, malfunctioning appliances and similar situations shall not constitute leaks which entitle the customer to a recalculated bill. The policy shall be maintained in the city clerk's office for inspection by the public and shall be applied in a non-discriminatory manner to all customers. The reasonableness of the utility's policy or practice with respect to a policy shall be subject to Commission review in a formal complaint proceeding.
