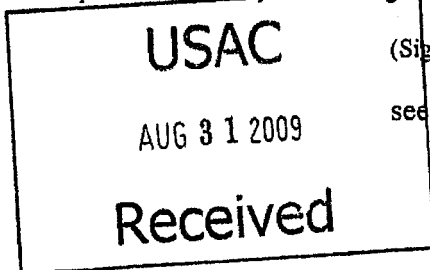

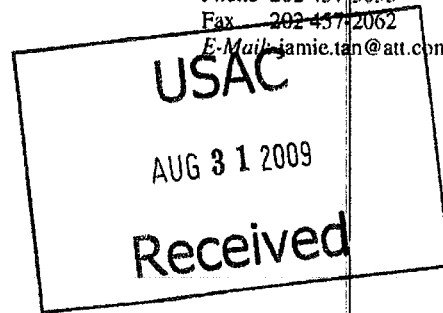

Re: 2009 Lifeline Certifications and Verifications Compliance Filing

To Whom It May Concern:

AT&T Mobility Corporation ("AT&T"), on behalf of its wholly-owned subsidiaries, hereby submits its annual Lifeline Certification and Verification filing. The Office of Management and Budget ("OMB")-approved Annual Lifeline Certification and Verification form requires that an officer of the companies named on the form make certain certifications and sign it. While the signatory of the attached documents is an officer of AT&T and responsible for the administration, implementation, and management of the Lifeline programs for the entities listed in the attached certifications, this officer is not an officer of any of the individual eligible telecommunications carriers ("ETC") referenced therein.

After consulting with Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") staff last year, AT&T filed its own, non-OMB-approved form with the Universal Service Administrative Company. The AT&T-created form contained all of the certifications of the OMB-approved form and was signed by the AT&T officer who had responsibilities for AT&T's participation in the Lifeline program. The AT&T form, however, did not state that the signing officer was an officer of the ETCs. Several weeks ago, AT&T contacted Commission staff to obtain permission to file AT&T's own Lifeline Certification and Verification form in lieu of the OMB-approved form. This year, Commission staff directed AT&T to complete and sign the OMB-approved form and attach a letter explaining, as above, that the signing officer has responsibilities for administering, implementing, and managing the Lifeline program for the entities listed in the attached and is authorized by AT&T to make the requisite certifications despite not being an officer of any of the individual ETCs listed.
