

In Case No. 08-0618-T-GI, U.S. Cellular was recertified as an ETC by Order entered September 16, 2008, and further clarified by Order entered June 10, 2009 in reopened Case No. 08-0618-T-GI.



I, the undersigned, being duly sworn, state as follows:

1. I am the Vice President, Legal and Regulatory Affairs of U.S. Cellular Corporation, FCC service area number 209005.
2. I am responsible for certifying Carrier's use of Federal High Cost Support Funds.
3. Carrier is a rural and non-rural competitive eligible telecommunications carrier within the meaning of Sec.214(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, and is eligible to receive universal service support pursuant to Sec.254(e) of the Act.
4. USCOC of Cumberland, Inc. and Hardy Cellular Telephone Company, Inc. (collectively "U.S. Cellular®" or "Carrier") was certified as an ETC, effective February 25, 2008, by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia ("Commission") in Case No. 07-2031-C-PC ("Order") and recertified on September 16, 2008 (and clarified by Order entered June 10, 2009), and September 29, 2009 (and clarified by Order entered November 9, 2009) in Case No. 08-0618-T-GI.
5. Carrier files this affidavit in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's order of May 23, 2001, in Docket No. 96-45, which requires states to certify to the Federal Communications Commission that all Federal High-Cost Support within this state be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended, and as ordered by the Commission in Case No. 10-0558-T-GI General Investigation Regarding Certification of Federal Universal Service Funding for Eligible Telecommunications Carriers in West Virginia on April 27, 2010.


6. Carrier hereby states the following:
- a. that it will use the Federal High Cost Support Funds only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended pursuant to Sec.254(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, and the Commission's Order in Case No. 10-0558-T-GI.
 - b. that, pursuant to ordering paragraph 1 in Case No. 10-0558-T-GI, its five year service quality improvement plan, including use of USF support and supporting map are included as Exhibit 1 (plan and use) and Exhibit 2 (map).
 - c. that, pursuant to ordering paragraph 2 in Case No. 10-0558-T-GI, its outage report for calendar year 2009 is included as Exhibit 3.
 - d. that, pursuant to ordering paragraph 3 in Case No. 10-0558-T-GI, the number of requests for service from potential customers that were unfulfilled in 2009 is included as Exhibit 4.
 - e. that, pursuant to ordering paragraph 4 in Case No. 10-0558-T-GI, there were 15 customer complaints in 2009, and .0726 customer complaints per 1000 handsets.
 - f. that, pursuant to Case No. 10-0558-T-GI, a list of mandatory surcharges and Federal Universal Service Charge and a comparison of U.S. Cellular® plan to the national urban benchmark is included as Exhibit 5.
 - g. that, pursuant to Case No. 10-0558-T-GI, U.S. Cellular®'s annual Lifeline Verification Compliance Certification is included as Exhibit 6.
 - h. in accordance with Commission Case No. 10-0558-T-GI (5), (6), (7), (8):
 - i. that it is in compliance with the CTIA Consumer Code for Wireless Carriers,
 - ii. that it will be able to function in emergency situations,
 - iii. that it continues to offer a local usage plan comparable to that offered by the incumbent local exchange telecommunications carrier in the relevant service areas,

- iv. that it acknowledges that the Commission may require it to provide equal access to long distance carriers in the event that no other eligible telecommunications carrier is providing equal access within the service area.

 with 2008 and 2009 USF Sites and Coverage

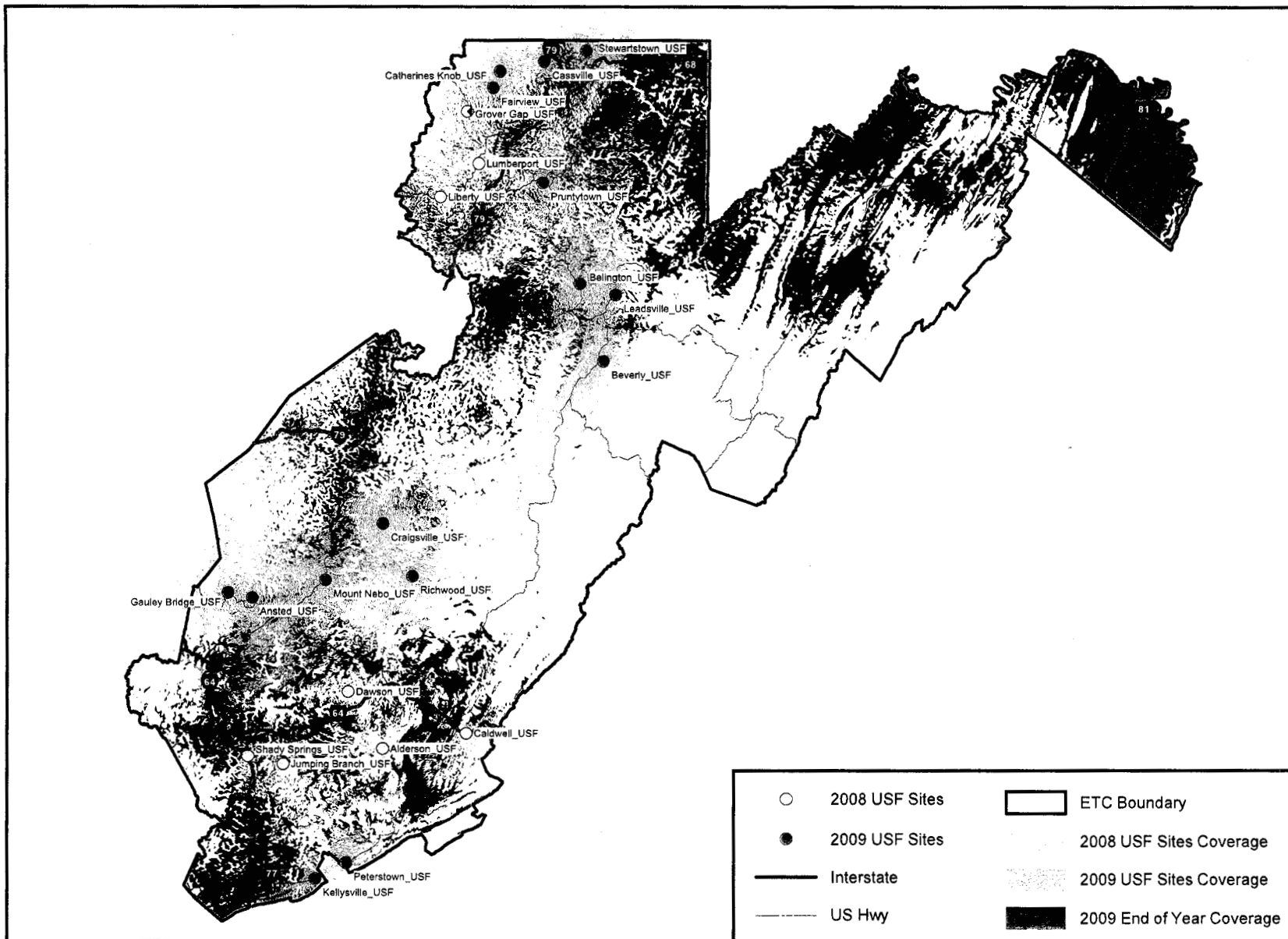


