PROCEDURAL ORDER

This Order sets the matter for hearing on September 8, 2016.

The matter should be set for hearing. The hearing should include Timberline Four Seasons Utilities, Inc. appearing and showing cause why a recommendation should not be made to the Commission that it immediately seek to place Timberline Four Seasons Utilities, Inc. into receivership pursuant to W. Va. Code §24-2-7(b). The hearing will also address the merits of all four proceedings.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the matter be, and hereby is, set for hearing in the Birch/Hawthorne Room, Canaan Valley Resort & Conference Center, Canaan Valley State Park, Route 32 North, Davis, at 1:00 p.m. on September 8, 2016. Timberline Four Seasons Utilities, Inc. shall appear at the hearing and show cause why a recommendation should not be made to the Commission that it immediately seek to place Timberline Four Seasons Utilities, Inc. into receivership pursuant to W. Va. Code §24-2-7(b). Evidence will also be received on the merits of each of the four proceedings.
