RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Sewerage Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

STEP 1

APPLICABILITY

Applicable within the entire territory served.

AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial sewer service.

RATES (Customers with metered water supply)

\$16.26 per 1,000 gallons of water usage per month.
(includes \$0.83 for reserve deficiency)

FLAT RATE (Customers with non-metered water supply)

Equivalent of 4,500 gallons of water usage \$73.17 per month.
(includes \$3.72 for reserve deficiency)

MINIMUM CHARGE

No bill will be rendered for less than \$32.52 per month.
(includes \$1.65 for reserve deficiency)

ENERGY CREDIT

All customers served by a septic tank effluent pump unit who also provide electricity to that pump shall receive a credit on their monthly bill equal to \$0.03 per 1,000 gallons used. This credit is to reimburse the customers for the electrical cost of pumping 1,000 gallons assuming a 20 GPM pump operation:

$.5 \text{ horsepower} \times .833 \text{ hours} \times \$0.07/\text{Kwh} = \$0.029 \text{ or } \$0.03 \text{ per 1,000 gallons}$

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the sewer utility up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.

STEP 1 (Continued)

DISCONNECT/RECONNECT/ADMINISTRATIVE FEES

Whenever water service has been disconnected for non-payment of sewer bills in conjunction with a water service termination agreement with the Town of Grant Town, Town of Rivesville, and/or the Town of Fairview, a disconnection fee of \$25.00 shall be charged; or in the event the delinquent sewer bill is collected by the water company, an administrative fee of \$25.00 shall be charged.

Whenever water service, which has been previously disconnected or otherwise withheld for non-payment of a sewer bill in conjunction with a water service termination agreement with the Town of Grant Town, Town of Rivesville, and/or the Town of Fairview, is reconnected, a reconnection fee of \$25.00 shall be charged.

Whenever water service has been disconnected for non-payment of sewer bills in conjunction with a water service termination agreement with Minister's Run Water Association and/or Monumental Public Service District, a disconnection fee of \$20.00 shall be charged; or in the event the delinquent sewer bill is collected by the water company, an administrative fee of \$20.00 shall be charged.

Whenever water service, which has been previously disconnected or otherwise withheld for non-payment of a sewer bill in conjunction with a water service termination agreement with the Minister's Run Water Association and/or Monumental Public Service District, is reconnected, a reconnection fee of \$20.00 shall be charged.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, or fifty dollars, whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.

STEP 1 (Continued)

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all current accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

(I) **TAP FEE**

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$4.05 per 1,000 gallons of water is to be used when a bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above customer's historical average usage.

STEP 1 (Continued)**(N) SURFACE GROUNDWATER SURCHARGE**

An additional amount shall be charged where surface or ground water is introduced into the sanitary system where evidence of a violation exists.

Surcharge formula to be applied in cases where surface drainage is connected to the utilities sewer system.

Whenever the utility has discovered that a customer's roof drain, downspout, storm sewer, or other similar facilities conducting surface water have been connected to the utility's sewer system, and such customer has failed to take appropriate action within thirty (30) days of receipt of a demand by the Utility, in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commission, to eliminate such connection, a surcharge will be imposed upon the customer calculated on the basis of the following formula:

$$S = A \times R \times .0006233 \times C$$

- S - The surcharge in dollars
- A - The area under roof and/or the area of any other water collection surface connected to the sanitary sewer, in square feet
- R - The measured monthly rainfall, in inches
- 0.0006233 - A conversion factor to change inches of rain x square feet of surface to thousands of gallons of water
- C - The utility's approved rate per thousand gallons of metered water usage.

The utility shall not impose the surcharge unless, and until, the customer has been notified by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by hand delivery, that it has been established by smoke testing, dye testing, or on-site inspection that rain or other surface water is being introduced into the sanitary sewer system at the customer's location, and that the customer has not acted within thirty (30) days from receipt of such notice to divert the water from the sanitary sewer system.

Said surcharge shall be calculated and imposed for each month that said condition continues to exist. Failure to pay the surcharge and/or correct the situation shall give rise to the possible termination of water service in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commission of West Virginia.

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

